DESIGN YOUR OWN COAT OF ARMS

In *Mice of the Round Table: A Tail of Camelot*, Calib Christopher places important meaning in his family's coat of arms, also known as a family crest. These are a special set of symbols and colors, typically displayed on a shield, that represent one's family. In medieval times, knights would wear these symbols to show their loyalty to powerful families and to identify who other knights were loyal to. The study of what these symbols mean and who they represent through history is called **heraldry**.

Below you can design a coat of arms that represents you. Coat of Arms can contain anything from animals, flowers, to simple stripes and shapes. Here are some suggestions to get you started:

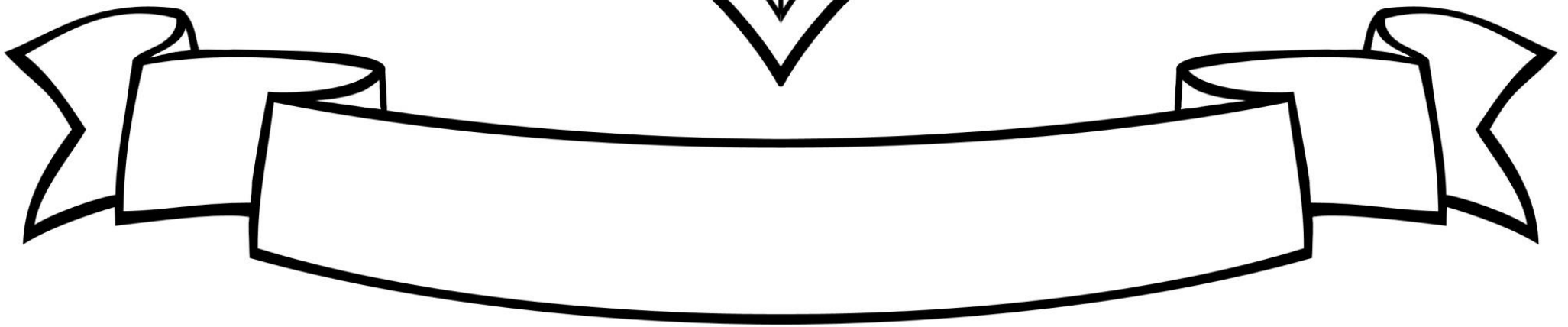
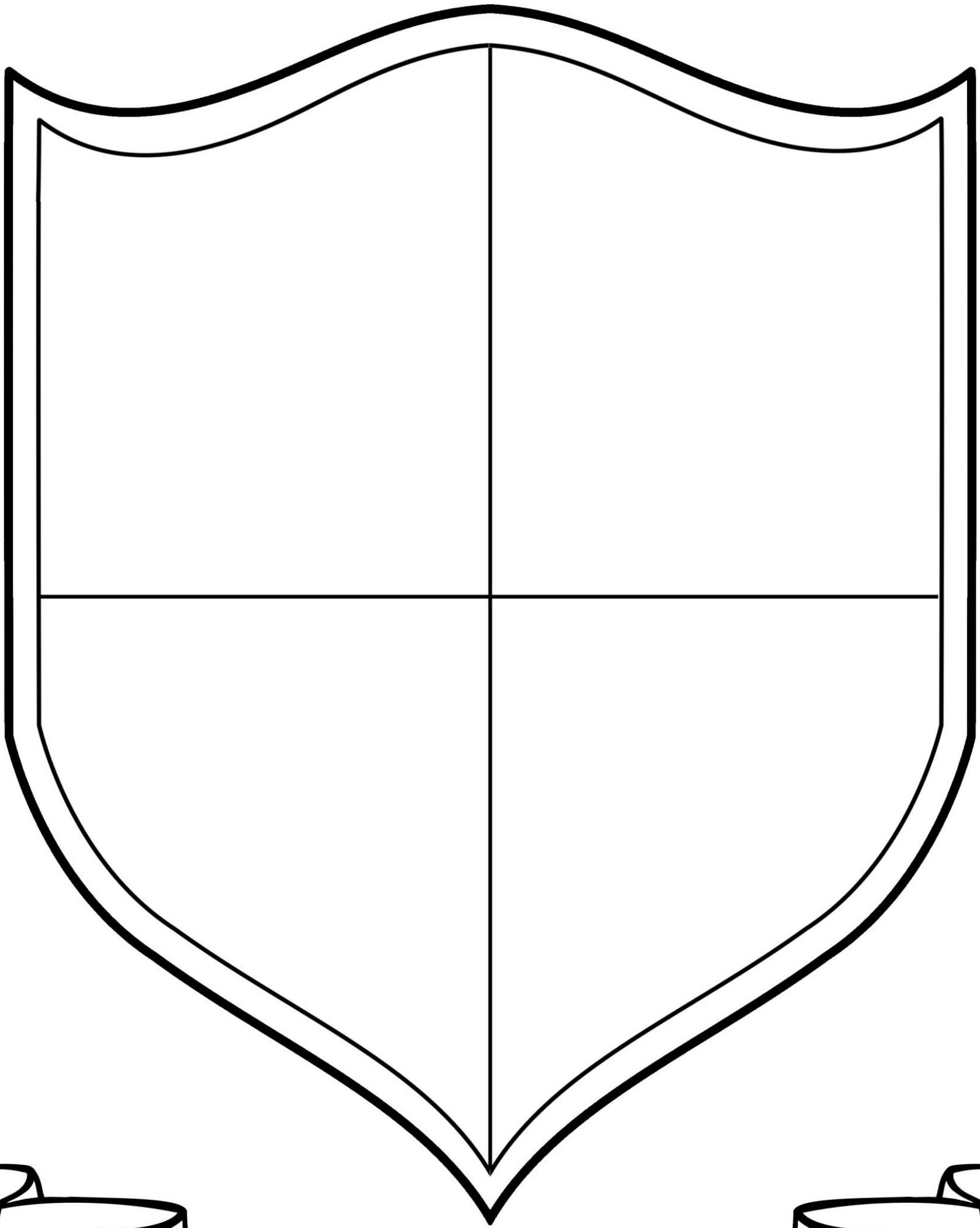
Top Left: Draw your favorite animal

Top Right: Draw your favorite shape in your favorite color

Bottom Left: Draw your favorite flower or plant

Bottom Right: Draw something that represents your favorite thing to do. For example, a book for reading or a ball for soccer.
